ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Identify proper specifications from cut sheets and job orders.

- Manually and digitally, set up wire cutting machines to job specifications.
- Basic maintenance and troubleshooting of wire cutting machines for proper setup and operation.
- Determine which applicator to use and learn how to set it up.
- Learn how to set up inkjet program and run it.
- Learn how to use a micrometer for crimp height checks on terminals.
- Inspect products to ensure they are within specifications.
- Minimize scrap through proper operation, maintenance, and set up of machines.
- Communicate problems with machine operation and set up to supervisor.
- Miscellaneous other duties as assigned by supervisor or management.

WORK ENVIRONMENT
