JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Gather and assemble sheet metal components and/or machine components
- Determine tooling and hardware components (rivets, clinch nuts, pem fasteners, retainers, Heli coil insert, etc...)
- Review drawing/router and identify features that needed for assembly
- Identify equipment needed for assembly processes such as:
 - o Di-acro/Haeger press
 - o Manual & air riveter
 - o Manual, air & electric Heli-coil installer
 - o Sealants & Adhesives
- Setup and run the job order
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or GED required
- 2 – 3 years machine assembly experience in a manufacturing environment
- Able to read and understand customer specifications, blue prints & bill of material
- Able to set up & operate hand tools, manual & hydraulic presses and heli-coil machines
- Must be able to perform close tolerance work
- Familiarity with inspection tools (i.e. calipers, height gage & thread gage)
- Ability to work with others
- Some light physical effort required; frequent lifting up to 5#; infrequent up to 30#
