

# School of Communication and Journalism - Position Announcement Assistant Professor/Tenure-Track/Public Relations

The Communication Studies Division within the School of Communication and Journalism at Eastern Illinois University seeks a qualified individual for a full-time (9 months), tenure-track assistant professorship in public relations. The successful candidate will primarily teach classes in the core curriculum of the B.A. in Public Relations as well as graduate classes in the school's graduate programs. The candidate will also be expected to teach undergraduate classes in the undergraduate communication studies program based on expertise and departmental need. Opportunities for summer employment exist for candidates with an interest in teaching online. Departmental committee and service assignments, research/creative activities, and professionally related service are expected.

### Minimum requirements

• Master's in Communication or related at time of hire.

### **Job Duties**

- Teach classes for the School of Communication & Journalism consistent with the load requirements outlined in the Unit A contract.
- Undergraduate courses in the core curriculum of the B.A. in Public Relations
- Graduate courses in the Communication Studies graduate program
- Undergraduate courses in the undergraduate communication studies program
- Online courses at both the undergraduate and graduate level.
- Conduct research and creative activities with high relevance to communication studies and public relations with the potential to lead to publications with reputable academic journals and/or presses
- Develop new courses connected to area of expertise such as social media analytics
- Lead students in high-impact learning opportunities
- Participate in departmental committees and complete other departmental service assignments
- Engage in university related service on committees across EIU and Professional/Disciplinary related service
- Participate in the advising of student organizations and teams (such as PRSSA & The Agency)
- Contribute to the growth of the Public Relations major by participating in student recruitment activities.
