**Responsibilities:**

- Acts as primary parts technician to locate and order shop supplies and equipment, and parts for off-road, medium and heavy duty trucks, and automotive parts for technicians or the Fleet Services Manager.
- Contacts vendors and maintains accurate inventory records for parts and supplies.
- Checks receiving invoices and packing slips to identify any discrepancies in orders.
- Maintains orderly storage of parts, supplies, and equipment to ensure efficient utilization of available storage and space.
- Inputs data into computer system to track inventory, vehicle parts disbursements, and related information.
- Runs basic inventory reports and completes physical inventories of parts and supplies on an annual basis and intermittently throughout the year.
- Picks up and delivers auto parts, supplies, and equipment from suppliers.
- Acts as backup to Senior Parts Technician to monitor supply of underground fuel, lubricants, and waste oil.
- Acts as backup to Senior Parts Technician to respond to underground storage tank alarms, other fuel site or underground fuel storage tank troubleshooting, and/or maintenance issues.
- Demonstrates open and honest communication, teamwork, professional growth & development, and constant improvement in the efficiency & effectiveness of work results.
- Performs all other duties as assigned.
